His 2011 debut album, containing the singles "The A Team" and "Lego House", was certified quintuple platinum in the United Kingdom. In 2012, he won two BRIT Awards for Best British Male and British Breakthrough which added to his **(famous)** "The A Team" won the Ivor Novello Award for Best Song musically and lyrically. Sheeran began to be **(to know)** in the United States in 2012. He made a guest **(to appear)** on Taylor Swift's fourth album, *Red*, and wrote songs for One Direction. "The A Team" was nominated for Song of the Year at the 2013 Grammy Awards and he performed the song in duet with Elton John during the ceremony. He spent much of 2013 **(to tour)** North America as the opening act for Taylor Swift's Red Tour. His second album is titled *x*, read as "multiply", and is scheduled for worldwide release on 23 June 2014. He was nominated for Best New Artist at the 56th Annual Grammy Awards.
